About the Sterling Awards

Celebrating 36 years of business excellence, the Sterling Award is one of the most coveted business awards in the Valley, with a rigorous application, judging and selection process. Four teams of judges each conduct an initial review of all applicants and narrow the field to three finalists in each category. Once the finalists are identified, the judging teams visit those companies to conduct a personal interview and get a behind-the-scenes look at the operations. Each judge then independently casts a set of points for the finalists based on their embodiment of the award criteria. The points are tallied, and the results remain secret until the day of the event. One of the highlights of the Sterling Awards celebration is the highly anticipated video presentation of each of the finalists, produced by Moorhouse Creative. The Sterling Awards were presented by Desert Financial Credit Union, and sponsors included COX Business, Nationwide, Prestige Cleaners, NewGen Business Solutions, Salt River Project, and the event production sponsor, Merestone. Only members of the Scottsdale Area Chamber of Commerce are eligible to apply for the Sterling Award.
